### Level 2

- · Limited eye contact.
- Speaks clearly some of the time.

### Level 1

- Does not make eye contact, reads presentation.
- Does not speak clearly.
- Unrehearsed and disorganized.
- Cannot address audience questions.

- Required content is included and accurate.
- Vocabulary included and used correctly.
- Complete understanding of concept.
- All sources correctly cited.
- Most content included and accurate.
- Vocabulary included, but with some inaccuracies.
- Basic understanding of concept.
- Sources cited but incorrectly.
- Content contains some inaccuracies.
- Some vocabulary included.
- Reflects slight understanding of the topic.
- Sources cited were incomplete and/or done incorrectly.
- Incomplete and inaccurate content.
- Most of the content required is not included.
- Little to no significant vocabulary included.
- Does not reflect understanding of the topic.
- No sources cited.

### • Complete, excellent quality with extra information.

- Went above and beyond requirements.
- Very creative.

#### Complete and creative.

- · Basic topics covered.
- Shows quality.

#### Almost complete.

- Average quality.
- Shows some creativity.
- Most topics included.
- · Incomplete.
- Poor quality.
- Lacking creativity.
- Not all topics included.

## Outstanding group collaboration.

- All members presented and were prepared.
- Critical thinking apparent.
- All tasks completed with some extra.
- Feedback was asked for and listened to and adjustments made as needed.

#### Group collaboration.

- All members presented.
- Critical thinking apparent.
- All tasks were done.
- Some feedback was asked for.

#### Limited group collaboration.

- Part of the group presented.
- Some critical thinking apparent.
- Most tasks were done.
- Did not ask for feedback.
- Group did not collaborate.
- Only one member presented.
- Critical thinking not apparent.
- Many tasks left undone.
- Did not ask for feedback.
